Equine Canada Statement of Principles

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion that they deserve, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all equestrians including owners, trainers, and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedures;
- providing current information on the Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization's rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition; and
- actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judges in accordance with the EC Rule Book **(A602.2)**

GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

ENTRIES – may not be accepted unless accompanied by:

1. Your stabling form if stabling
2. Your signed waiver (same page as stabling form)
3. Your accurate and complete entry form
4. For Silver – copy of your EC Horse Recording is Required
5. Your current dated cheque if mailing entry, made payable to **RCRA**

Faxed or Emailed entries are subject to a \$25.00 service charge if not paid in full on same day. This can be done by including your credit card information for payment. If payment is being mailed it must be received prior to closing date or the entry will ALSO be considered late and incur a LATE FEE	Incomplete entries are subject to a \$10.00 service charge at the discretion of the secretary
Late entries are those received and/or fully paid after Midnight on closing date are subject to a \$40.00 late fee, and will only be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee.	Any cheques returned by the bank for any reason, are subject to a minimum \$50.00 fee.
The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse entries.	

CATEGORIES	All classes will offer the Open category. If there are more than four (4) entries per category at any level the organizing committee has the option of separately grouping any category for the purpose of placings and awards. If a category is not indicated on the entry form the rider will automatically be put in the Open category
CANCELLATIONS	Cancellations will only be accepted with a Veterinarian or Physician Certificate. Refunds of 100% of entry and stabling fees, less administration fee, will be allowed up until the closing date. Refunds of 50% of class entry fees, less administration fee, will be made after the closing date. There will be no refunds on stabling fees after the closing date.
HORS CONCOURS	Hors Concours entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organizing committee and these entries

	will ride last in the class.
Memberships	All riders and owners must have an EC Sport Licence at the Bronze Level, Silver Level or higher and a PSO (OEF) membership.
NUMBERS	All competition and non-showing horses must wear a number at all times in the schooling and exercise areas and in the competition rings. Passports will be returned upon return of number. Failure to display the number as required May incur elimination or disqualification.
NON-SHOWING HORSES	There is a \$50.00 fee per day for non-showing horses and are only accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee
RIDING TIMES	Riding times will be available at www.rcra.ca or www.foxvillage.com on the Wednesday prior to show date. As times get changed frequently prior to each day it is the competitor's responsibility to check for current times each competition day.
STABLING	The cost per stall is \$185.00 for the weekend (Fri afternoon-Sun afternoon) or \$140.00 for Sat am to Sun afternoon. While we try to accommodate all requests and work primarily on a first come basis, <u>stabling assignment is at the discretion of the organizer</u> . Stalls will not be bedded, please bring your own shavings or shavings will be available at \$9.00 per bag. Please bring your own hay, feed and buckets. Stabling opens at 2 pm on Friday and horses must leave by 8pm on Sunday. Day stabling may be available if space permits. The cost is \$75 per day and is only for the period of 7 am to 6 pm for that one day, no overnights . If day stabling is booked with the entry and not available that fee will be fully refunded.
HELMETS	EC Rules, Section E, Dressage ARTICLE E 4.0 SAFETY HEADGEAR: All riders, regardless of age or level or competition, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. Note: At the tack check which follows the test, the steward May ask the rider to dismount so that the helmet May be inspected for the ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN label .
QUERIES	Questions concerning rules, scoring or entries May be made to the Steward for discussion with the Organizing Committee. Protests must be made in writing within 48 hours of the completion of the class and accompanied by a deposit of \$200.00, cash or certified cheque. See EC Rules
DRUG TESTING	EC/FEI Drug and Medications rules apply at these shows. Any horse entered in any class at any competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location
INSURANCE	All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events is necessary.
RIBBONS	Ribbons will be presented to 6 th place as well as division champion and reserve champion in divisions that have 4 or more competitors. In classes or divisions with less than 6 competitors, classes and or divisions May be combined at the discretion of the organizing committee.
FREESTYLE MUSIC	Must be submitted when competitor package is picked up and on CD or USB.
PARKING	Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only or may be towed at the owners expense. There will be no parking on the roads and the barn areas at any time . After unloading, please do not park in the stable area.
SECURITY	Security will not be provided. The show organizers and the facility accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave items unattended.
DOGS	If you must bring your furry friend each must be on a leash. As well, please make sure 1. you stoop & scoop , 2. do not allow your friend to run loose, 3. you use a leash that can extend no longer than 2 metres. Penalties will be levied for any offenders.
Warm up	Warm up will be available as posted. Competition rings will be open to riders on Friday until 6 pm. After that time, competition rings will be available at the discretion of the organizer. Please ensure that you wear your competition number at all times.
REFUNDS	Competitors owed any refund of fees will receive their refund no earlier than 2 weeks after the competition if they paid by cheque.
OTHER	Substitutions are permitted at the discretion of the competition organizer The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason.

“Per Article A801, every entry at an EC-sanctioned competition shall constitute an agreement by the person responsible that the owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver or rider and horse shall be subject to the constitution and all rules of Equestrian Canada and any additional rules set by the competition. It is the responsibility of all individuals participating in any capacity in EC-sanctioned competitions to be knowledgeable regarding the EC constitution and the applicable rules of EC and the additional rules, if any, imposed by the competition. Do not participate in this EC-sanctioned competition in any capacity if you do not consent to be bound by the constitution and rules of EC and any additional rules imposed by the competition.”

Every entry at a Royal Canadian Riding Academy (RCRA) event shall constitute an agreement that the person making it (owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider) and the horse shall be subject to the Constitution and the Rules of Equestrian Canada, the local rules of RCRA and the facility, and that the owner and/or participant and any of their representatives are bound by the Constitution and the Rules of Equestrian Canada, RCRA and the facility; accept as final the decision of the Hearing committee on any questions arising under said rules and agree to hold RCRA, the facility, E.C., their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken.

I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of Equestrian Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless the E.C., RCRA, the facility, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. The person responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC. **(A802.4) Must be signed by the person responsible**

I acknowledge that any activity involving horses is high risk including but not limited to:

- (a) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that May result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bite or kick other animals, people or objects;
- (b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
- (c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that May contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities to maintain control over an equine

In addition to consideration given for my Participation in this RCRA event being held at RCRA, in 2017, I and my heirs, executors, administrations and assigns agree;

- **To Waive ALL Claims that I might have against the** Organizing Committee, RCRA, B.G. Schickedanz (York) Inc. as well as their directors, officers, agents, representatives, employees, officials, members, volunteers and the owners or occupier of the land upon which the event is held (all of them collectively hereinafter referred to as the "HOST"); and
