Special Needs/ Concerns

1. The Owner agrees to hold B.G. Schickedanz (York) Inc o/a Royal Canadian Riding Academy (referred to in this agreement as the "Stable"), its agents and/or employees completely harmless and not liable for any death or injury whatsoever caused to the Owner, the Horse and/or any loss or damage to any personal property.
 2. The Owner accepts full responsibility for the safety of any of his/her visitors and or riders they may bring on the Stable premises.
 3. The Horse and all tack and equipment of the Owner lodged on the Stable premises shall be at the sole risk of the Owner, who assumes all responsibility for the insuring of the tack and equipment owned by him/her, while on the Stable premises.
 4. The Owner agrees to execute the Stable's Agreement for Release and Waiver, and **will ensure all visitors arranged by the Owner to ride the Owner's Horse at any time will have first executed the Stable's Agreement for Release and Waiver prior to riding.**
 5. The Owner agrees to wear correct and proper headgear and footwear, and acknowledge the Stable recommends approved headgear be worn at all times while mounted. If the Owner is a minor, the parent/guardian signing this Agreement acknowledges the Owner/minor has been instructed by the parent/guardian to wear approved headgear while mounted at all times.
 6. The Owner shall ensure that any of his/her visitors or riders wear correct and proper headgear and footwear, and that if the visitors or riders are minors they must wear approved headgear while mounted at all times.
 7. The Owner agrees to abide by and conform to all rules and regulations as determined and posted from time to time by the Stable.
 8. On arrival to the premises of the Stable, the Owner's Horse shall be free from infectious, contagious or transmittable disease. The following documents shall be supplied by the Owner to the Stable prior to the arrival of Horse:
 - A Veterinarian Health Certificate qualifying as a negative Coggins test dated within twelve (12) months prior to the arrival date, and a health, de-worming and immunization record.
- The Stable reserves the right to refuse the Horse within **ten (10) days** of the date of arrival, the quarantine period, if not in proper health.
9. During the time that the Horse is in the custody of the Stable, the Stable shall not be liable for any sickness, disease, astray, theft, death or injury which may be suffered by the Horse or any other cause of action whatsoever arising out of or connected in any way with the boarding of said Horse. This includes, but is not limited to, any personal injury or disability the Horse may receive on the Stable premises.
 10. The Owner fully understands the Stable does not carry any insurance on any horse not owned by it for boarding or any other purposes, and that the Horse is not covered under any public liability, accidental injury, theft, or equine mortality insurance and that all risks connected with the boarding or for any other reason for which the Horse is in the possession of and on the premises of the Stable, are to be borne by the Owner.
 11. The Stable agrees to provide de-worming of the Horse as is reasonable and necessary. The Stable has a worming program whereby all horses resident on the premises are de-wormed at regular intervals. The expense for these services shall be invoiced to the Owner by the Stable or by the Veterinarian arranged to provide the service, and shall be payable by the Owner within 30 days of the invoice date.
 12. The Owner agrees to arrange for all veterinary and farrier services required for the health and well-being of the Horse at the Owner's expense. In the event of an emergency, the Stable agrees to attempt to contact the Owner

Should the Stable feel that emergency medical treatment is needed for the said horse, but if the Stable is unable to reach the Owner or the Owner's veterinarian immediately, then the Stable is authorized to secure emergency veterinary and blacksmith care required for the health and well-being of the Horse. All costs of such care secured, as well as all routine veterinary expenses for examination, care and treatment of the Horse, shall be invoiced to the Owner as an additional expense. Said costs shall be payable by the Owner within 30 days of the invoice date.

13. Any additional feed required such as supplements or vitamins are to be provided at the Owner's expense. The Stable is to be advised in writing of all supplements being fed.

14. The boarding fee made payable to "Royal Canadian Riding Academy" is due in advance of the first (1st) day of each month by cash, debit, cheque or Visa/MasterCard. The Owner understands that there will be a **late payment charge of \$15.00 per day** thereafter until full boarding fees are paid. The Owner agrees to provide the Stable with twelve (12) post-dated cheques or a Visa/MasterCard authorization for the first year of boarding fees prior to boarding the Horse. The Owner further agrees to provide the Stable with twelve (12) postdated cheques or a Visa or MasterCard authorization for each subsequent year prior to each anniversary of the boarding of the Horse. Any additional costs, as outlined in this agreement shall be invoiced separately. **NSF or other returned cheques will result in a \$50.00 plus HST charge per occurrence plus late payment charges. No exceptions.**

15. **The Owner shall pay the Stable for Full Board services, as described below, the amount of \$775.00 plus 13% HST (\$100.75) for a total of \$875.75 per month.** The Owner acknowledges from time to time the board rate will change. The Stable will provide written notice of board rate changes by posting notices on the Stable premises at least **thirty (30) days** prior to the board rate change coming into effect.

16. The full boarding package shall include the following Stable services:

Stall as assigned	Bedding as provided by Stable
Grain as provided by Stable	Two (2) grain feeds per day
Hay as provided by Stable	Blanketing (Owner to provide)
Daily stall mucking	Boots for turn out if needed (Owner to provide)
Daily turn out – weather permitting – in a paddock as assigned	
Feeding of special grain if provided by the Owner	
Feeding of supplements if provided by the Owner	
One (1) locker/horse in tack room	Use of boarder lounge as designated
Shared use of common facilities including Arena 2 and 3, washrooms, outdoor rings, tack room, wash stalls, and parking areas.	
Riding is available in rings during posted barn hours.	

The stable reserves the right to change the hours of arena/ring use without notice.

Additional services may be available from the Stable on a fee per service basis, information is available at the Stable's Administration office.

17. The Owner may arrange riding lessons with Royal Canadian Riding Academy instructors at additional expense. Outside coaching is permitted with RCRA's consent, only coaches with approved certification and current insurance, proof of submitted to the Stable. A \$35.00 fee is required on a per lesson basis for ANY outside coaches permitted to teach on RCRA property

18. The Owner acknowledges from time to time the Stable will be hosting and renting the facilities for events and equestrian competitions which will use areas of the common facilities. Stable will endeavour to make available alternative areas and times for the use of the Owner during these events and notices will be posted on Stable premises.

19. Should the Owner desire the Stable to release the Horse to any third party, the Owner must provide to the Stable his/ her written consent to such a release before the Stable will give possession of the Horse to a third party.

20. Right of Lien

The Owner or agent(s) of the Horse shall be jointly and severally liable for all sums due hereunder to the Stable. The Owner is put on notice that the Stable has right of lien, as set forth under the Repair & Storage Liens Act of Ontario and any other applicable legislation in Ontario for the amount due for the board and keep of the Horse and shall have the right to retain the Horse until the amount of such indebtedness is discharged. The Stable shall be authorized to proceed by lien and lien foreclosure, sale, legal action or otherwise in order to collect the same, or any combination of the above. Upon sale of the Horse, the Owner and/or agent of the Horse shall be responsible and liable for any deficiency in unpaid sums.

21. This Boarding Agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties and there are no further agreements or promises, verbal or implied unless specifically stated herein. When the Stable and the Owner and/or the Owner's parent or legal guardian, if the Owner is a minor, sign this Agreement it will be binding on both parties subject to the above terms and conditions.

22. By the purchase of the entry and attendance at any event at RCRA, the Entrant consents to the use and broadcast of his or her image, without payment of consideration, in any news broadcast, internet broadcast, commercial broadcasts, advertising or promotional publicity for the Royal Canadian Riding Academy.
