Rules and Regulations – please return a signed copy of this page with each entry form

- Riders competing in the Beginner Division may choose to be on a lead line
- Short Stirrup and Cross Rail Classes will not contain oxers
- Short Stirrup division restricted to riders 13 years of age and under as of January 1st 2020
- For riders entered in the HI/LOW Working Hunter Division, riders will have the option to compete in either class 15 (2'6") or 16 (2'9") and points will count towards an overall division ranking vs individual class rankings
- The first division will start at 8:00am sharp. All other classes are subject to change based on the number of entries received. A second schedule will be posted two days prior to the show with exact times
- Entries for divisions 1 and 6 are restricted to one division per rider
- Division 6 riders may be on the lead line
- RCRA reserves the right to cancel any class at any time
- Classes will run with a minimum of 5 entries per class for classes 2 through 10 and a minimum of 5 entries per class for classes 12 through 19
- Schooling classes will run regardless of number of entries
- All entries are non-refundable regardless of cancelation cause, the only exception will be if RCRA is the party to cancel
- A late fee of \$10.00 per class will be charged to any entry form submitted within 48 hours of the start of each show
- The stall rental for the day of the show includes use of the allocated dry stall from 5:00am – 10:00pm
- 30 hour stall rental includes use of the allocated dry stall from 4:00pm the night before the show date until 10:00pm the night of the show date
- Stall rentals are for dry stalls including use of the wash stall for water but do not including hay or shavings. Bags of shavings can be provided for an extra fee. Hay will not be provided.
- Riders will have the option to stable their horses at RCRA for any length of time surrounding the show dates for additional fees
- Sign in will begin at 7:00am on each day of the series in the RCRA show office
- All divisions will take place in the RCRA show arena, Arena One
- Location within the RCRA facility is subject to change
- The Award dinner will take place after the completion of the final class on March 29th and will be an extra fee that will cover the cost of the dinner
