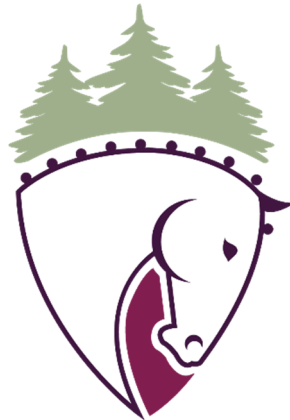

**Equestrian Canada Statement of Principles**

Equestrian Canada (EC), the national equestrian federation of Canada, supports adherence to humane treatment of horses in all activities under its jurisdiction.

All Persons shall be committed to:

- upholding the welfare of horses, regardless of value, as a primary consideration in all activities;
- requiring that horses be treated with kindness, respect, and the compassion, and that they never be subjected to mistreatment;
- ensuring that all equestrians including owners, trainers, and competitors, or their respective agents, use responsible care in the handling, treatment and transportation of their own horses as well as horses placed in their care for any purpose;
- providing for the continuous well-being of horses by encouraging routine inspection and consultation with health care professionals and competition officials to achieve the highest possible standards of nutrition, health, comfort, and safety as a matter of standard operating procedures;
- providing current information on the Code of Practice for the Care and Handling of Equines and other equine health and welfare initiatives;
- continuing to support scientific studies on equine health and welfare;
- requiring owners, trainers and competitors to know and follow their sanctioning organization’s rules, and to work within industry regulations in all equestrian competition; and
- actively promoting the development and adherence of competition rules and regulations that protect the welfare of the horse.

The standard by which conduct or treatment will be measured is that which a person who is informed and experienced in generally accepted equine training and competition procedures would determine to be neither cruel, abusive nor inhumane.

Every class offered herein is covered by the rules and specifications of the current rules of EC and will be held and judges in accordance with the EC Rule Book **(A602.2)**

## GENERAL RULES AND REGULATIONS

**ENTRIES** – may not be accepted unless accompanied by:

1. Your stabling form if stabling & signed waiver (same page as stabling form)
2. Your current dated cheque if mailing entry, made payable to **RCRA**. E-Transfers are accepted at [RCRAaddressage@gmail.com](mailto:RCRAaddressage@gmail.com)
3. Current Covid-19 information form will be email to every entry and must be returned complete prior to the Wednesday before the show or you will not be admitted to the grounds.

<p><b>Faxed or Emailed</b> entries are subject to a \$25.00 service charge <b>ONLY if not paid in full on same day</b>. This can be done by including your credit card information for payment. If payment is being mailed it must be received prior to closing date or the entry will <b>ALSO</b> be considered late and incur a LATE FEE</p>	<p><b>Incomplete</b> entries are subject to a \$10.00 service charge at the discretion of the secretary</p>
<p><b>Late</b> entries are those received and/or fully paid after Midnight on closing date are subject to a \$40.00 late fee, and will only be accepted at the discretion of the Show Committee.</p>	<p><b>Any cheques returned</b> by the bank for any reason, are subject to a minimum \$60.00 fee.</p>
<p>ANY FEES OUTSTANDING for 15 days after the competition will be reported to EC for COLLECTION</p>	

- COVID-19 Protocols** All entries will receive current protocols and requirements upon receipt of their entry. Following the EC requirements of participation in 2020 and due to the changing number of permitted participants in the show area at one time, all entries need to be aware that there may be restrictions on who can attend with them. This means there may or may not be restrictions on the following people: Spectators, Coach, Groom, trailering persons, etc.
- Categories** All classes will offer the Open category. If there are more than **four (4)** entries per category at any level the organizing committee has the option of separately grouping any category for the purpose of placings and awards. If a category is not indicated on the entry form the rider will automatically be put in the Open category.
- Cancellations** Cancellations will only be accepted with a Veterinarian or Physician Certificate. Refunds of 100% of entry and stabling fees, less administration fee, will be allowed up until the closing date. Refunds of 50% of class entry fees, less administration/medic fee, will be made after the closing date. There will be **no** refunds on stabling fees after the closing date.
- Hors Concours** Hors Concours entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organizing committee and these entries will ride first in the class.
- Memberships** All riders and owners must have an EC Sport Licence at the same level (Bronze, Silver, Gold) or higher that the level they are competing and a PSO (OE) membership.
- Horse Recording number** For Silver and Gold entries, all Canadian entries are required to hold an EC Horse Recording and have paid the EC Horse Recording annual Activation Fee to compete, or if owned by a temporary sport license holder, a Temporary Horse Registration form must be purchased at each competition entered. Foreign entries must sign an affidavit. (See A404).
- Numbers** All competition and non-showing horses must wear a number at all times in the schooling and exercise areas and in the competition rings. Failure to display the number as required may incur elimination or disqualification.
- Non-Showing Horses** There is a \$25 per day fee for non-showing horses and are only accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Committee.
- Riding Times** Riding times will be available at [www.rcra.ca](http://www.rcra.ca) or [www.foxvillage.com](http://www.foxvillage.com) on the **Wednesday** prior to show date. As times get changed frequently prior to each day it is the competitor's responsibility to check for current times each competition day.
- Stabling** The cost per stall is **\$120.00** for the weekend (Fri afternoon not before 2 pm-Sun afternoon) or **\$50.00** per day or any part thereof. While we try to accommodate all requests and work primarily on a first come basis, stabling assignment is at the discretion of the organizer. Stalls will not be bedded, please bring your own shavings or shavings will be available at **\$9.00** per bag. Please bring your own hay, feed and

buckets. **Stabling opens at 2 pm on Friday and horses must leave by 6pm on Sunday.**

**Covid-19:** ALL horses stabling **MUST** have a tack stall as no equipment or supplies can be stored in the aisle at any time. Tack stalls can be shared with a maximum of 2 other horses, or a total of 3 horses per tack stall.

<b>Helmets</b>	<b>EC Rules, Section E, Dressage ARTICLE E 4.0 SAFETY HEADGEAR:</b> All riders, regardless of age or level or competition, must wear ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN approved protective headgear at all times when mounted at any EC-sanctioned Dressage competition at the event location. <b>Note:</b> At the tack check which follows the test, the steward May ask the rider to dismount so that the helmet May be inspected for the ASTM/SEI or BSI/BS EN label.
<b>Queries</b>	Questions concerning rules, scoring or entries May be made to the Steward for discussion with the Organizing Committee. Protests must be made in writing within 48 hours of the completion of the class and accompanied by a deposit of \$100.00, cash or certified cheque. See EC Rules
<b>Drug Testing</b>	EC/FEI Drug and Medications rules apply at these shows. Any horse entered in any class at any competition may be selected for equine medication control testing while at the event location
<b>Insurance</b>	All owners and competitors are personally responsible for damages to third parties caused by themselves, their employees, their agents or their horses. Third party insurance providing full coverage for participation in equestrian events is necessary.
<b>Ribbons</b>	Ribbons will be presented to 6 <sup>th</sup> place for each show. Division champion and reserve champion will be presented per show and determined by totaling all scores at each level and each rider must ride at least two tests at the level. To be declared a Champion, qualifying scores must be 60% or higher. To be declared a Reserve Champion, qualifying scores must be 58% or higher. Categories will be combined where there are fewer than 3 competitors in each category or split at the discretion of the show committee.
<b>Freestyle Music</b>	<b>Must be submitted when competitor package is picked up and on USB or Emailed ahead of time (BEST CHOICE). DO NOT BRING A CD as we have no way to play it.</b>
<b>Parking</b>	Vehicles must be parked in designated areas only or may be towed at the owners expense. There will be <b>no parking on the roads and the barn areas at any time.</b> After unloading, please do not park in the stable area.
<b>Security</b>	Security will not be provided. The show organizers and the facility accept no responsibility for lost or stolen items. Please do not leave items unattended.
<b>Warm up</b>	<b>Warm up will be available as posted.</b> Competition rings will be open to riders on Friday until 6 pm. After that time, competition rings will be available at the discretion of the organizer. Please ensure that you wear your competition number at all times.
<b>Refunds</b>	Competitors owed any refund of fees will receive their refund no earlier than 2 weeks after the competition if they paid by cheque.
<b>HST</b>	All fees listed in this prize list are subject to 13% HST
<b>Other</b>	Substitutions are permitted at the discretion of the competition organizer The organizing committee reserves the right to refuse any entry for any reason.

#### **Western Style Dressage Classes**

Classes are listed by test number and all levels (Introductory, Basic, Levels 1-4) are offered as EC miscellaneous classes in the Bronze competition and not rated for EC awards. On your entry for each test please specify your level(s) and division (Pro/Amateur/Junior). All classes and tests are run under WSDAC rules which are available at [www.westernstyledressage.ca](http://www.westernstyledressage.ca)

Every entry at a Royal Canadian Riding Academy (RCRA) event shall constitute an agreement that the person making it (owner, lessee, trainer, manager, agent, coach, driver, rider) and the horse shall be subject to the Constitution and the Rules of Equestrian Canada, the local rules of RCRA and the facility, and that the owner and/or participant and any of their representatives are bound by the Constitution and the Rules of Equestrian Canada, RCRA and the facility; accept as final the decision of the Hearing committee on any questions arising under said rules and agree to hold RCRA, H2S Management Inc., the facility, E.C., their officials, directors and employees harmless for any action taken.

I hereby certify that every horse, rider and/or driver is eligible as entered and agree for myself and my representatives to be bound by the Constitution and Rules of Equestrian Canada at this competition. It is hereby recognized that all equestrian sports involve inherent risk and that no helmet or protective equipment can protect against all foreseeable injury. I hereby accept this risk and hold harmless the E.C., RCRA, the facility, the competition, their officials, organizers, agents, employees and their representatives. The person responsible (PR) agrees to the release of any information on the entry form to EC. **(A802.4) Must be signed by the person responsible**

I acknowledge that any activity involving horses is high risk including but not limited to:

- (a) the propensity of any equine to behave in ways that may result in injury, harm or death to persons on or around them and to potentially collide with, bite or kick other animals, people or objects;
- (b) the unpredictability of an equine's reaction to such things as sounds, sudden movement, tremors, vibrations, unfamiliar objects, persons or other animals and hazards such as subsurface objects;
- (c) the potential for other participants to behave in a negligent manner that may contribute to injury to themselves or others, including failing to act within their abilities to maintain control over an equine

In addition to consideration given for my Participation in this RCRA event being held at RCRA, in 2021, I and my heirs, executors, administrations and assigns agree;

- **To Waive ALL Claims that I might have against the** Organizing Committee, H2S Management Inc., RCRA, B.G. Schickedanz (York) Inc. as well as their directors, officers, agents, representatives, employees, officials, members, volunteers and the owners or occupier of the land upon which the event is held (all of them collectively hereinafter referred to as the "HOST"); and
- **To Release the "HOST" from Any and All Liability** for any loss, damages, injury, or expense that I or my "Legal Representatives" might suffer as a result of my Participation due to any cause whatsoever **including any NEGLIGENCE ON THE PART OF THE "HOST"**; and

## **Welcome to the NDPC, our ponies to the North!**

The National Dressage Pony Cup is pleased to announce that we have added a Canadian Year-End Awards program, and that any Equestrian Canada sanctioned show can now become an NDPC Partner Show. Scores from Bronze, Silver, and Gold Level competitions will be eligible to become Partner Shows.

This program is offered to provide appreciation and rewards for the achievements of ponies of all breeds, whether or not they have papers, that may find themselves at a disadvantage when compared to larger horses in the show ring. While the size of a pony should not be an issue in the performance of a dressage test, some competitors can feel that they are not taken as seriously, or scored as well as they might have been, if their mount had been over 16 hands.

Many competitors ride ponies and find themselves in a competitive “no man’s land”, where they can feel a lack of appreciation for the performance and dedication that they bring to the sport. Many adult amateur competitors feel as though their choice of a mount that is more compatible with their stature, gives them a feeling of being more balanced and in sync with the movements that they are striving to learn. Gaits that are not as jarring to the joints, and the ability to use your leg effectively makes it possible to work in better partnership.

The NDPC wants to encourage competitors of all ages, sizes, and abilities to enjoy the experience of coming into a dressage show pony environment that is welcoming and feels fair.

The NDPC Year-End Awards compiles the scores of ponies for its members throughout all Canadian provinces, and will update the standings on a monthly basis.

We look forward to seeing all of the fabulous ponies that Canada has to offer and wish all of you a fun and safe competition season.

## **SMALL HORSE DIVISION**

### **Welcome to a special program created to honour the dressage achievements of small horses!**

The National Dressage Pony Cup Small Horse Division is designed to give smaller equines, their riders, trainers, and owners a place to be rewarded for their achievements in the wonderful sport and art of dressage. The NDPC understands the challenges that face these talented equines in the competition environment, and wants to give these athletes a special award program all their own.

To be eligible, each horse/rider combination must become members of the NDPC US or Canada Small Horse Division. A rider may add additional Small Horses to their own membership at the rate of \$10.00 per additional horse.

The NDPC competition season begins November 1, and concludes October 31. Memberships for the current season will be accepted until Midnight Eastern October 31. Members must complete the **NDPC Small Horse Measurement Form\***, and submit it to the NDPC by Midnight Eastern October 31.

A small horse, as designated by the National Dressage Pony Cup, is any breed of horse or pony that measures taller than a pony, but less than 163cm with shoes. This is the equivalent of 16hh. The official NDPC range is more than 149cm without shoes (150cm with shoes), to less than 162cm without shoes (163cm with shoes). The measurement must be taken in centimeters. The original measurement form, or a scanned copy of the original form, may be submitted as proof of measurement. Measurement forms must be submitted yearly until the horse reaches 8 years of age. Once the horse is 8 years old the measurement will be considered permanent.
